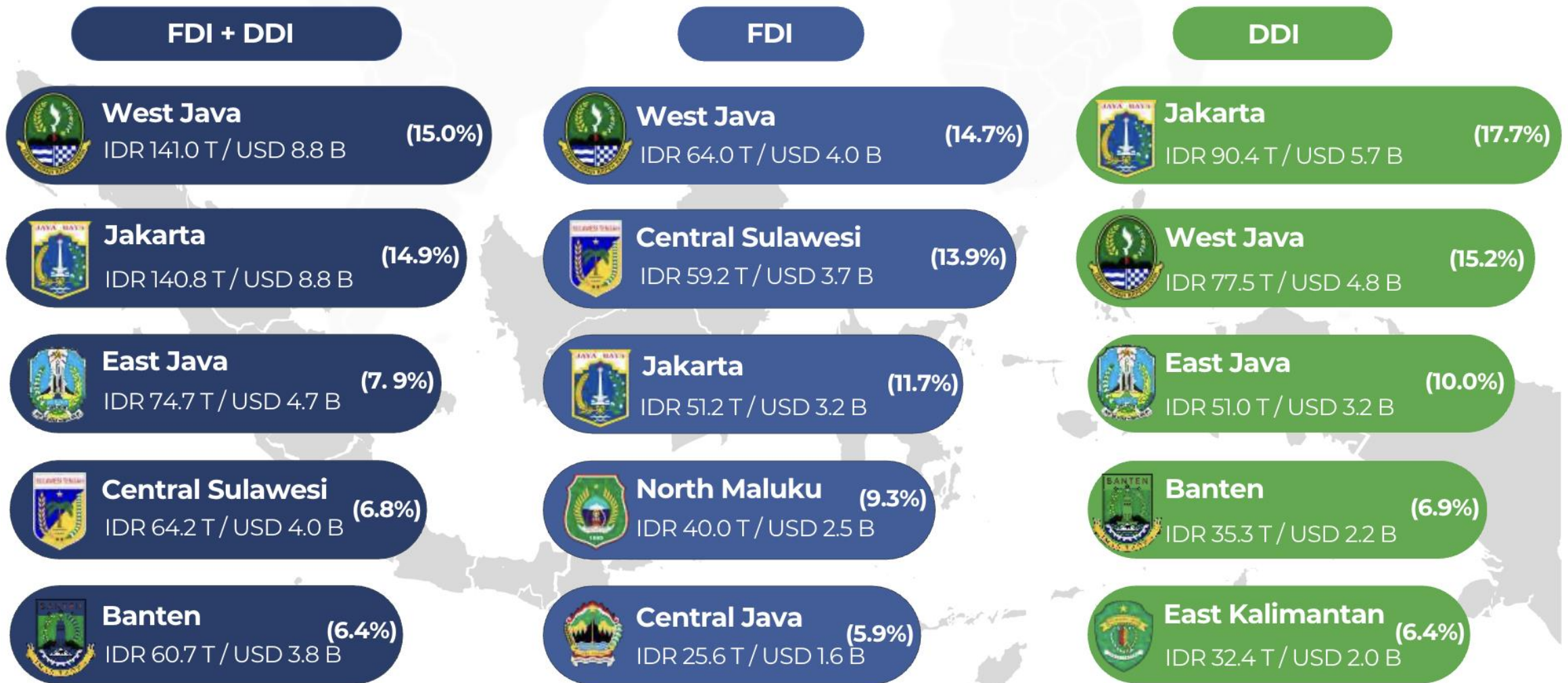

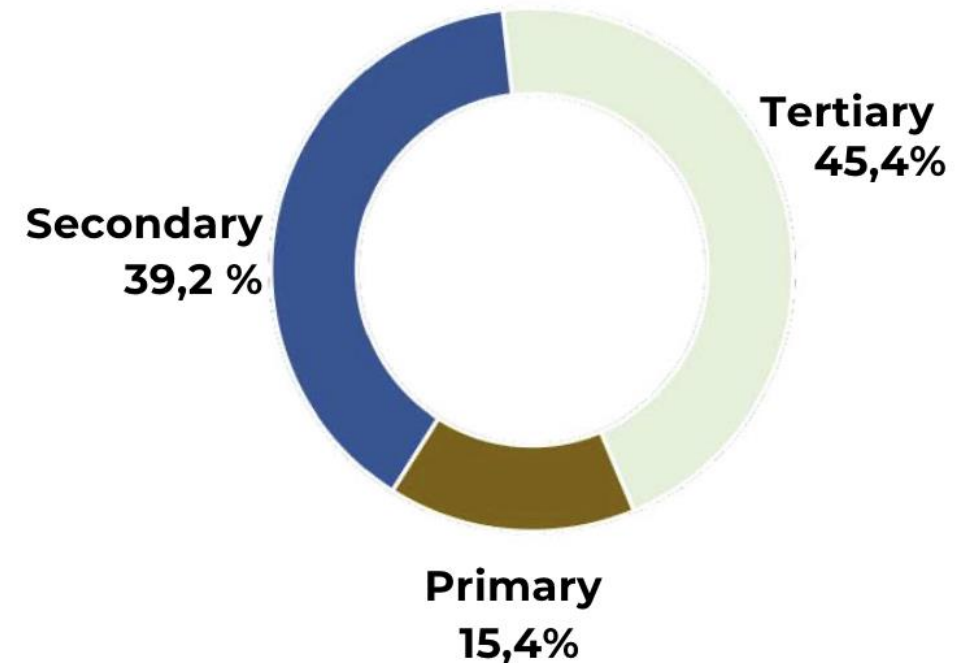

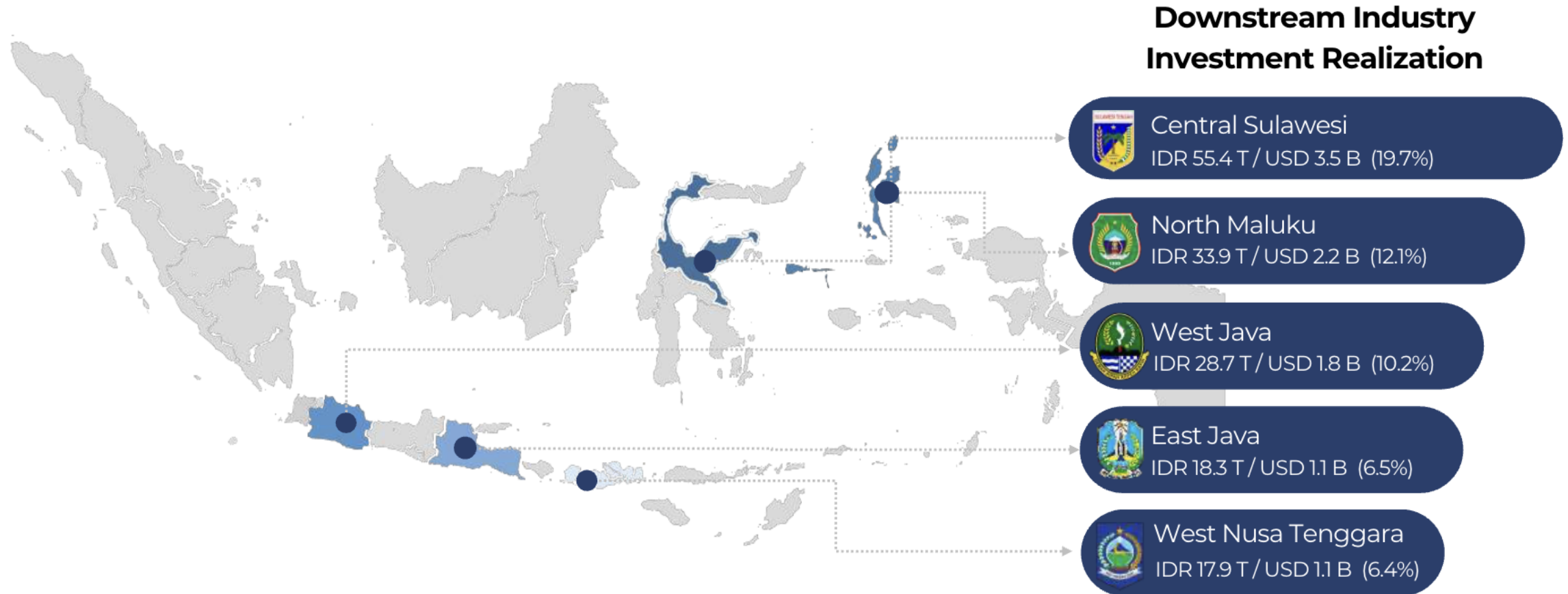

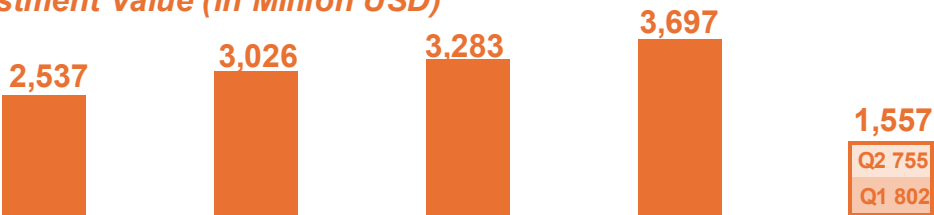

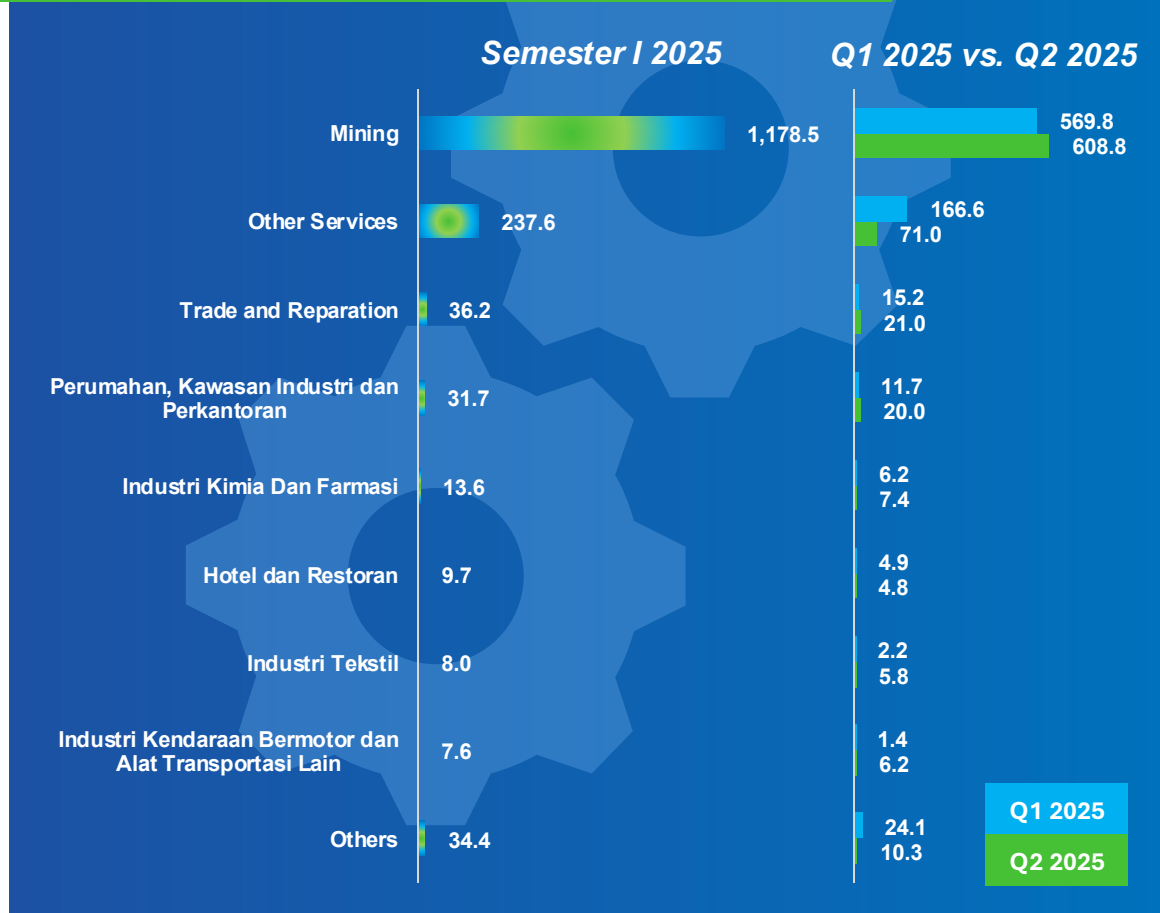

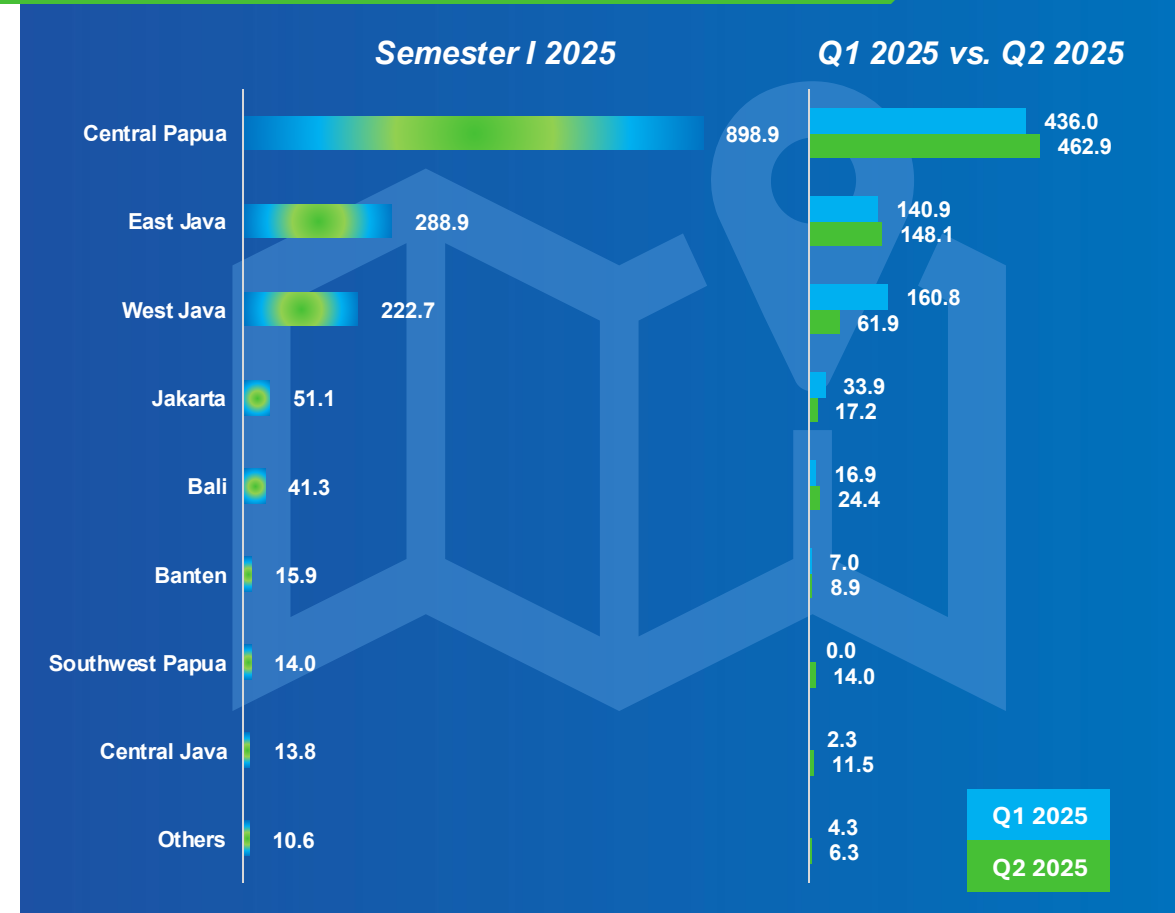

Top Investment Locations (USD Million) 2025



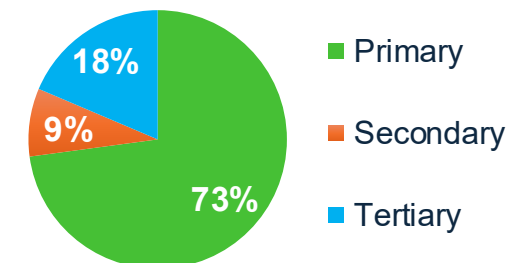

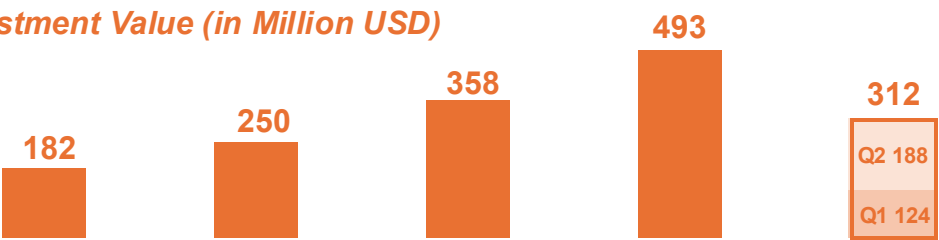

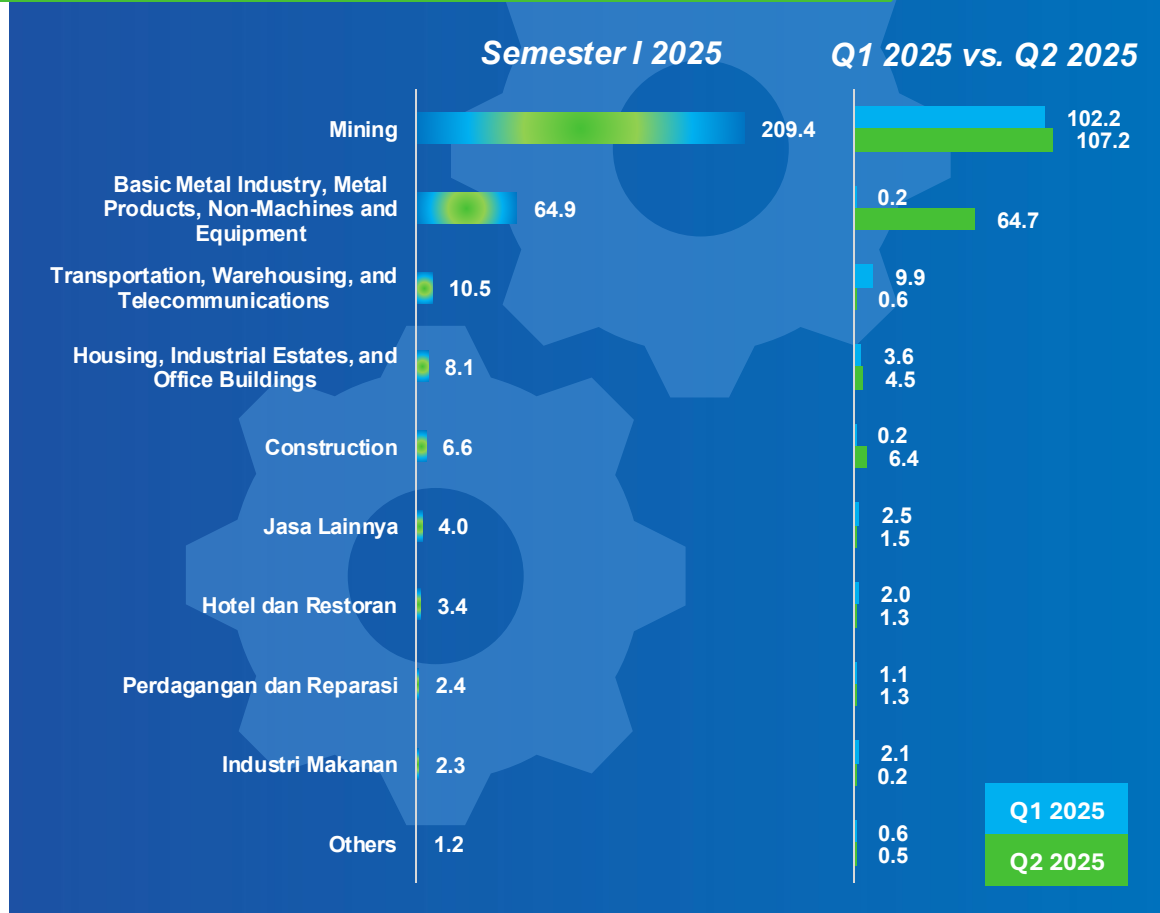

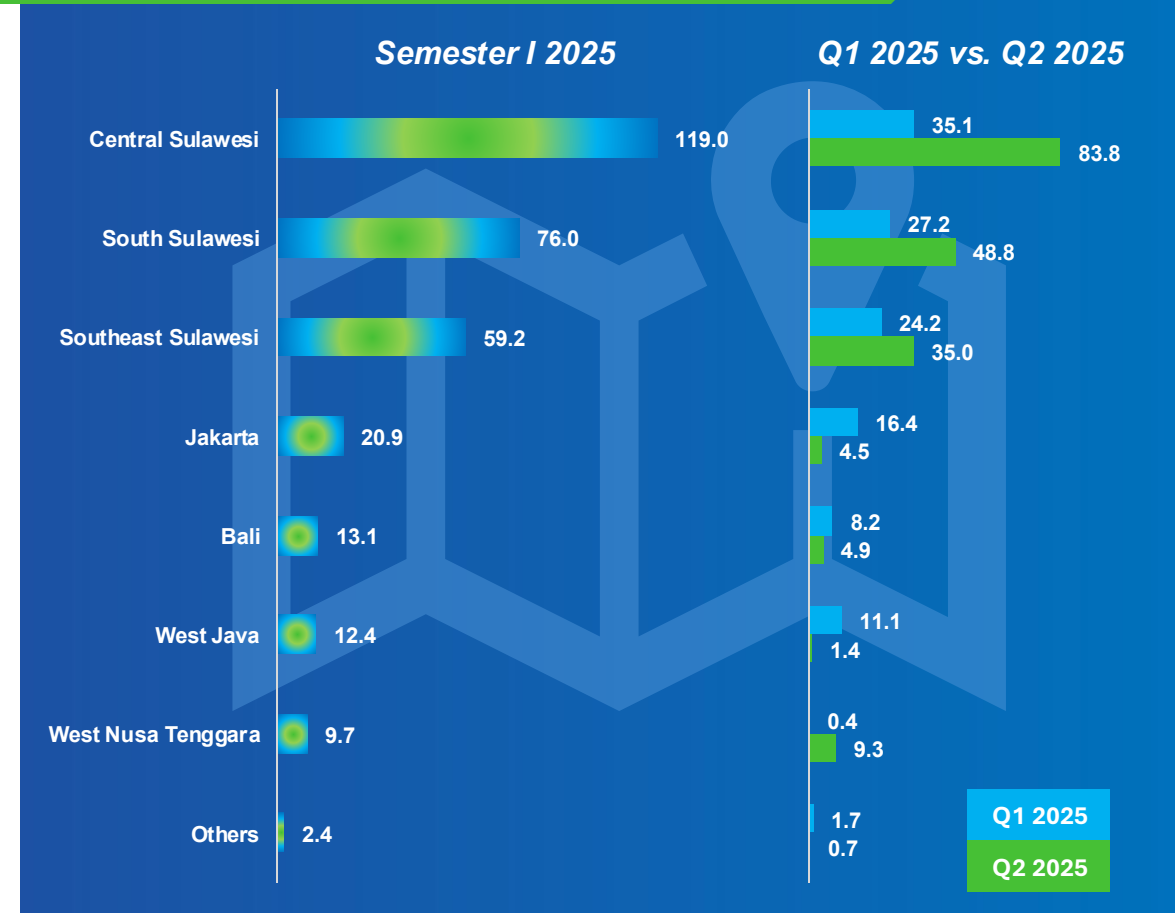

Top Investment Locations (USD Million) 2025



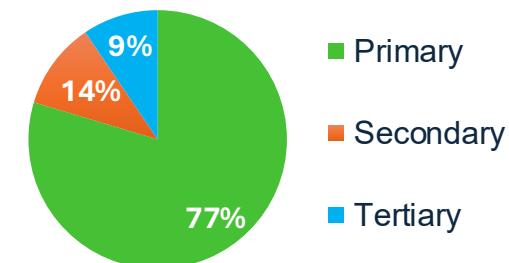

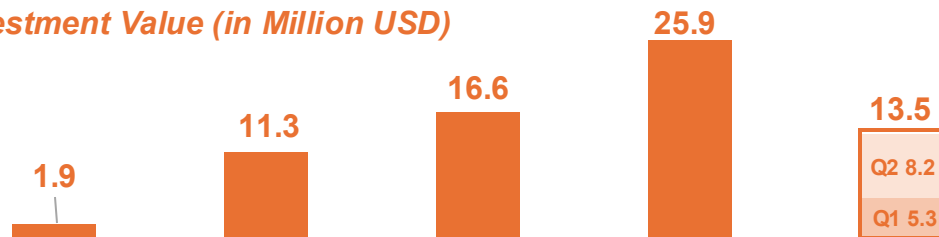

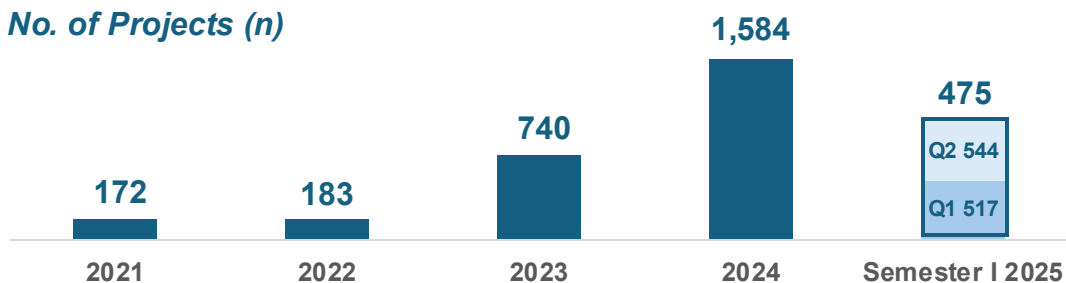

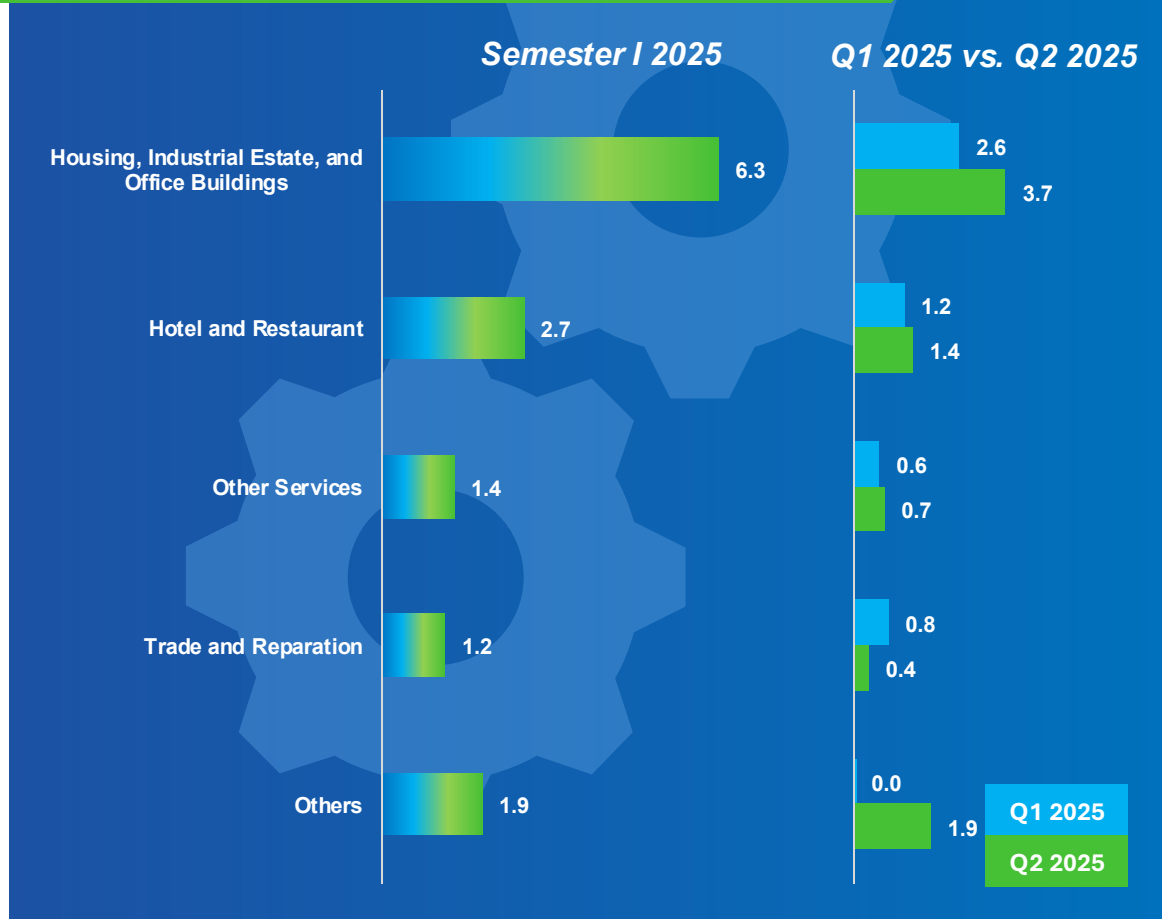

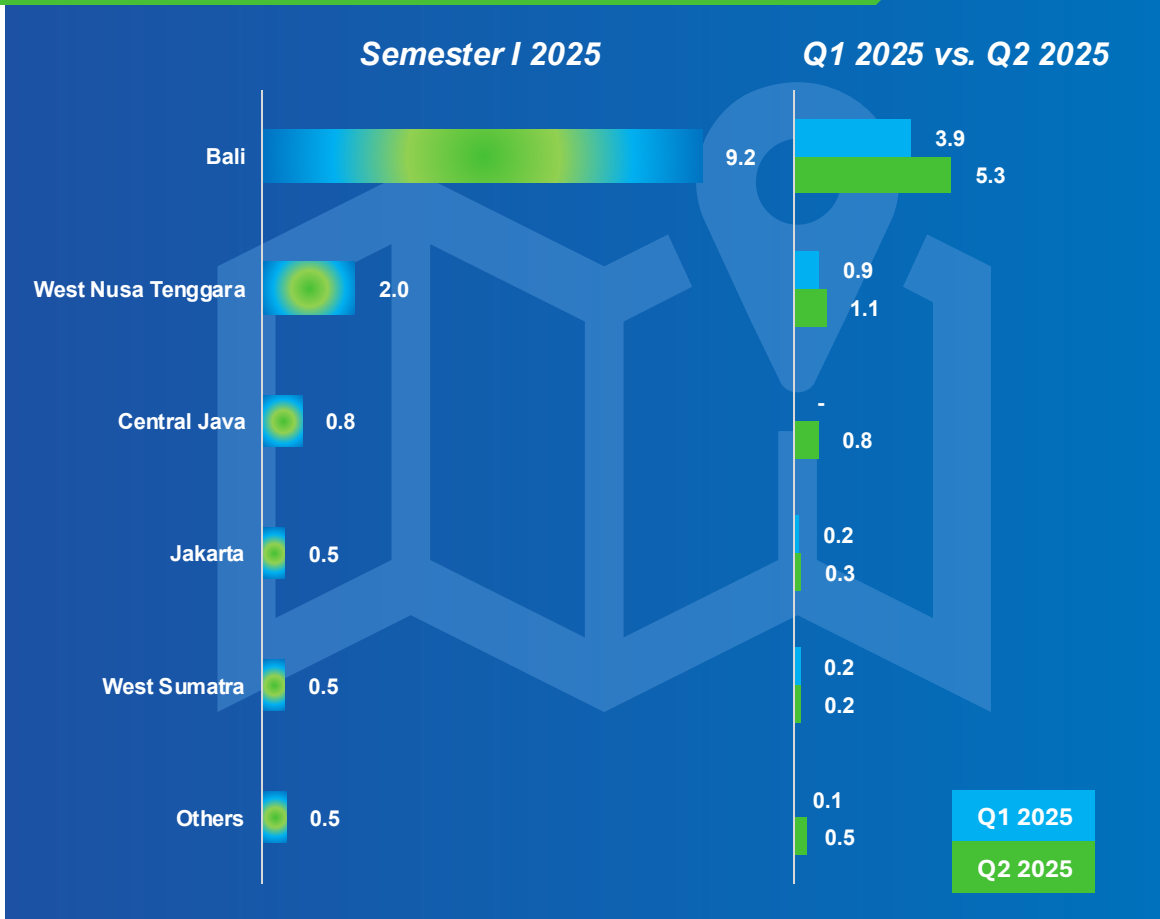

Top Investment Locations (USD Million) 2025



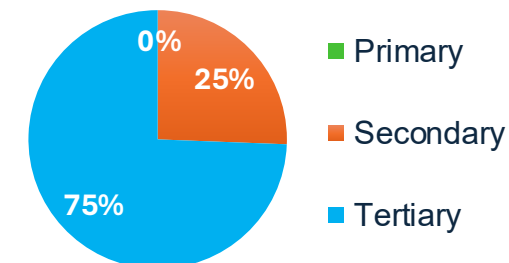
