Top 5 Downstream Industry Location

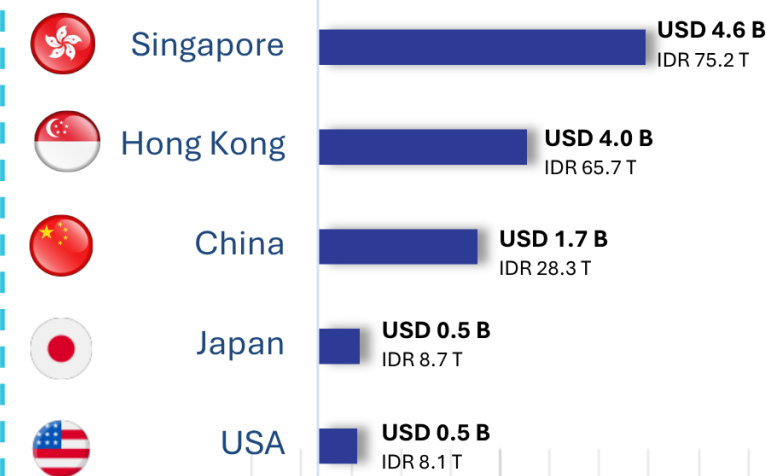


Top 5 FDI Origins (IDR T)

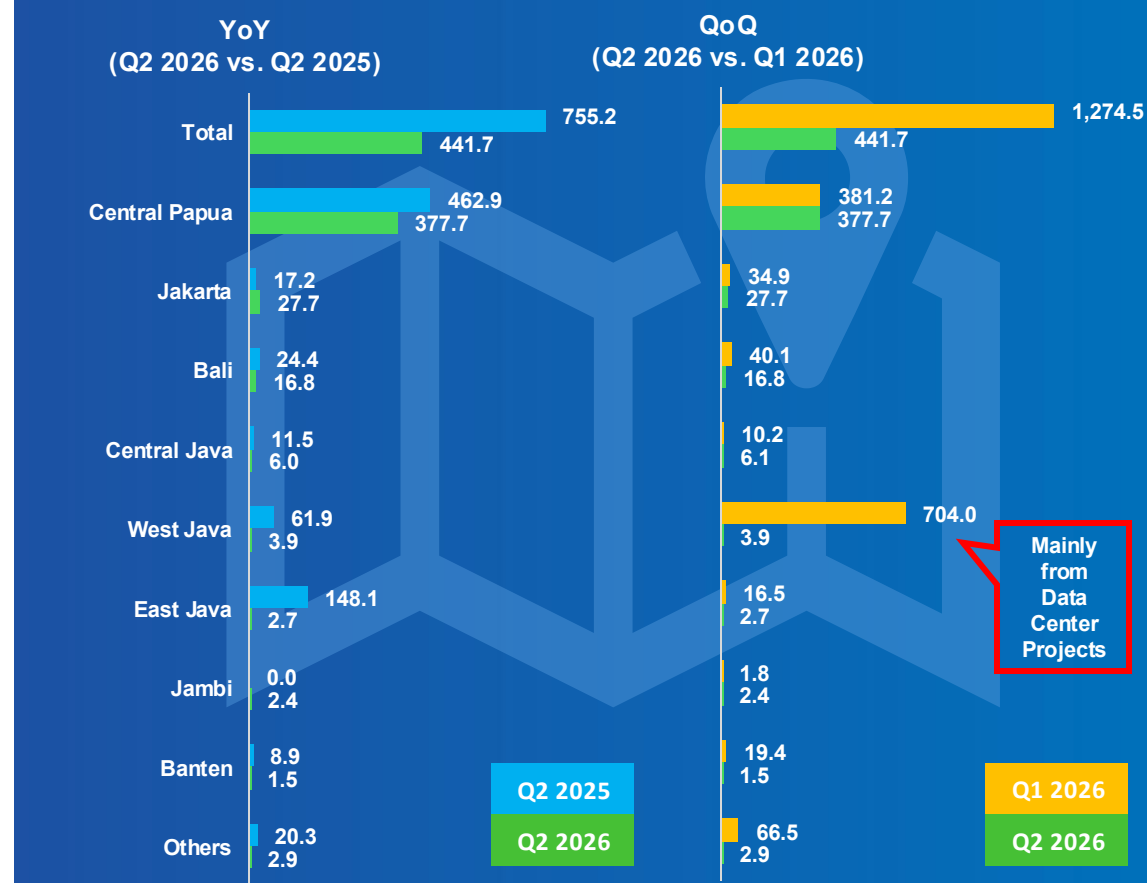
US Investment Realization in Indonesia – by Quarter

Top Investment Sectors (USD Million) 2026



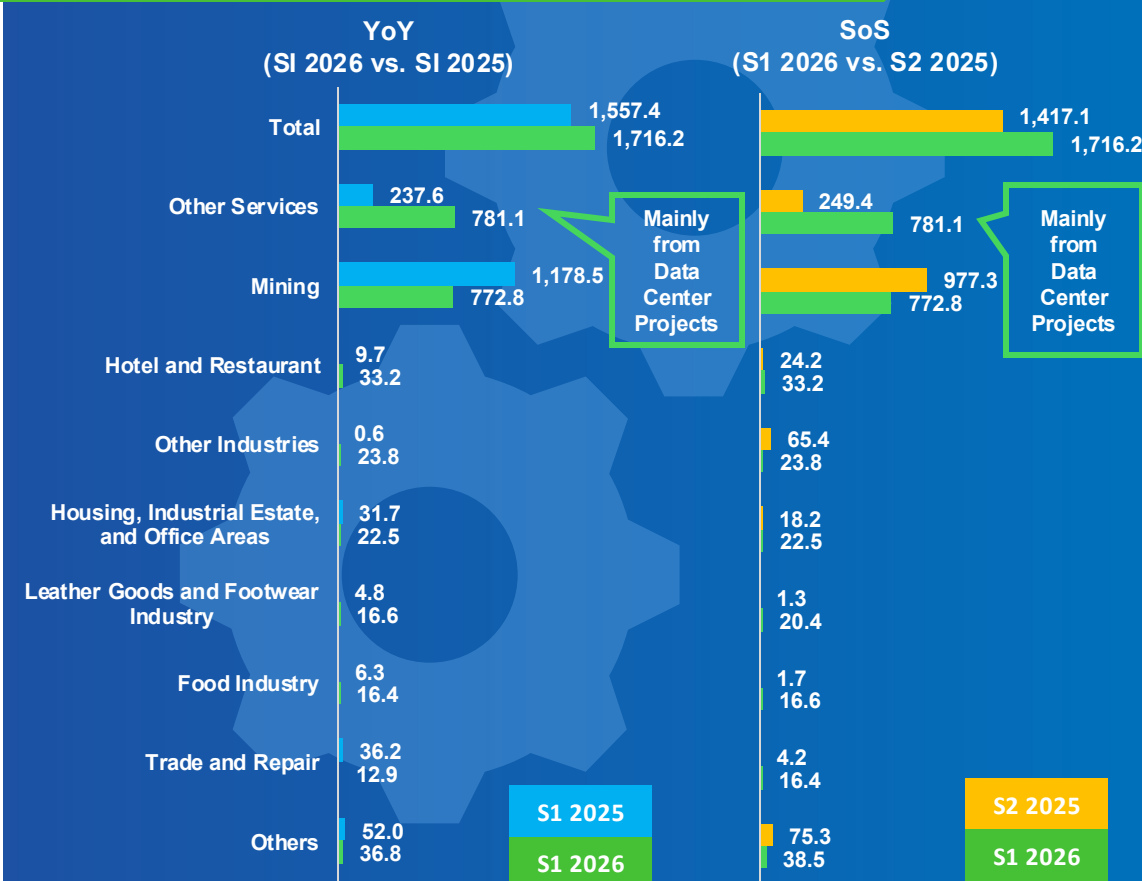
Top Investment Locations (USD Million) 2026



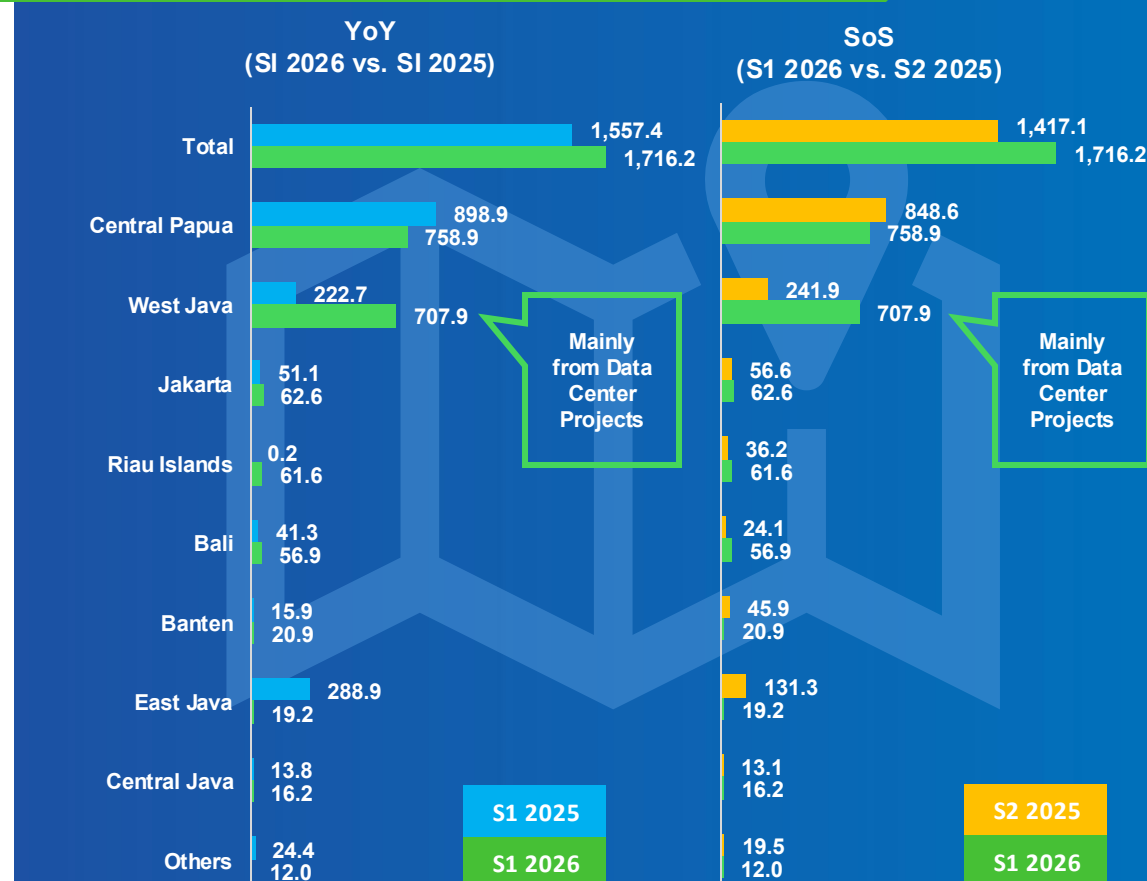

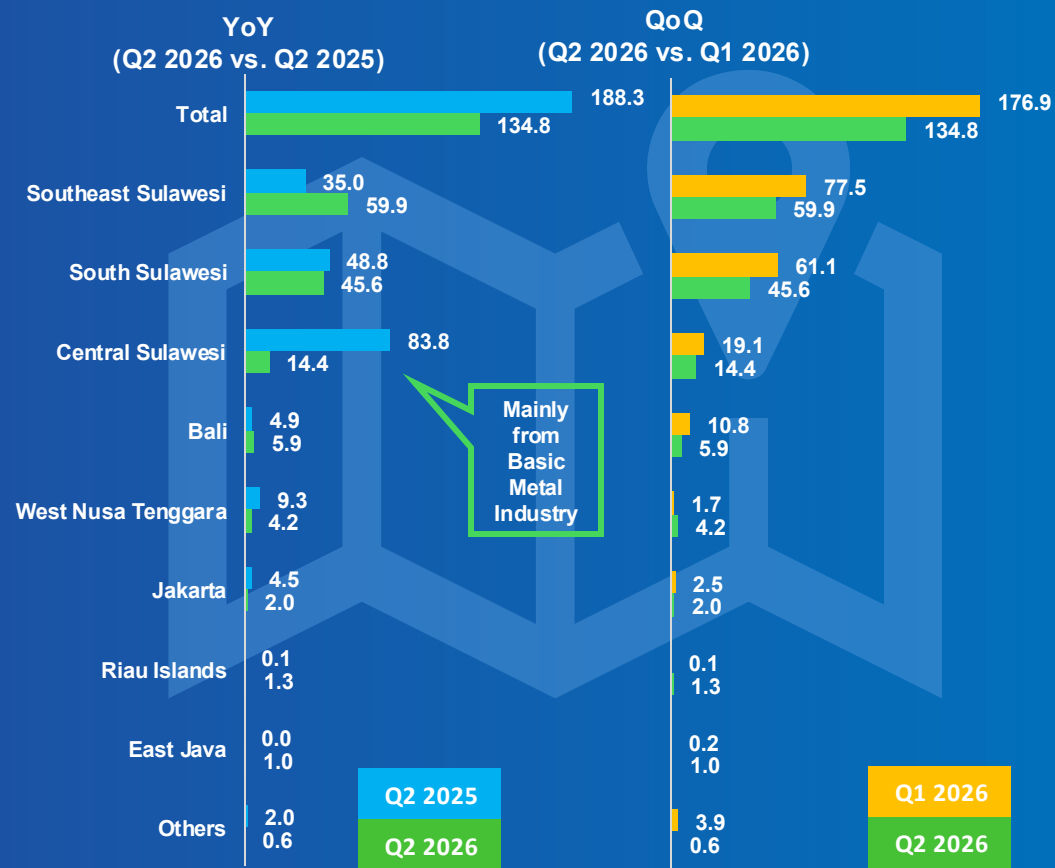
Canada Investment Realization in Indonesia – by Quarter

Top Investment Sectors (USD Million) 2026



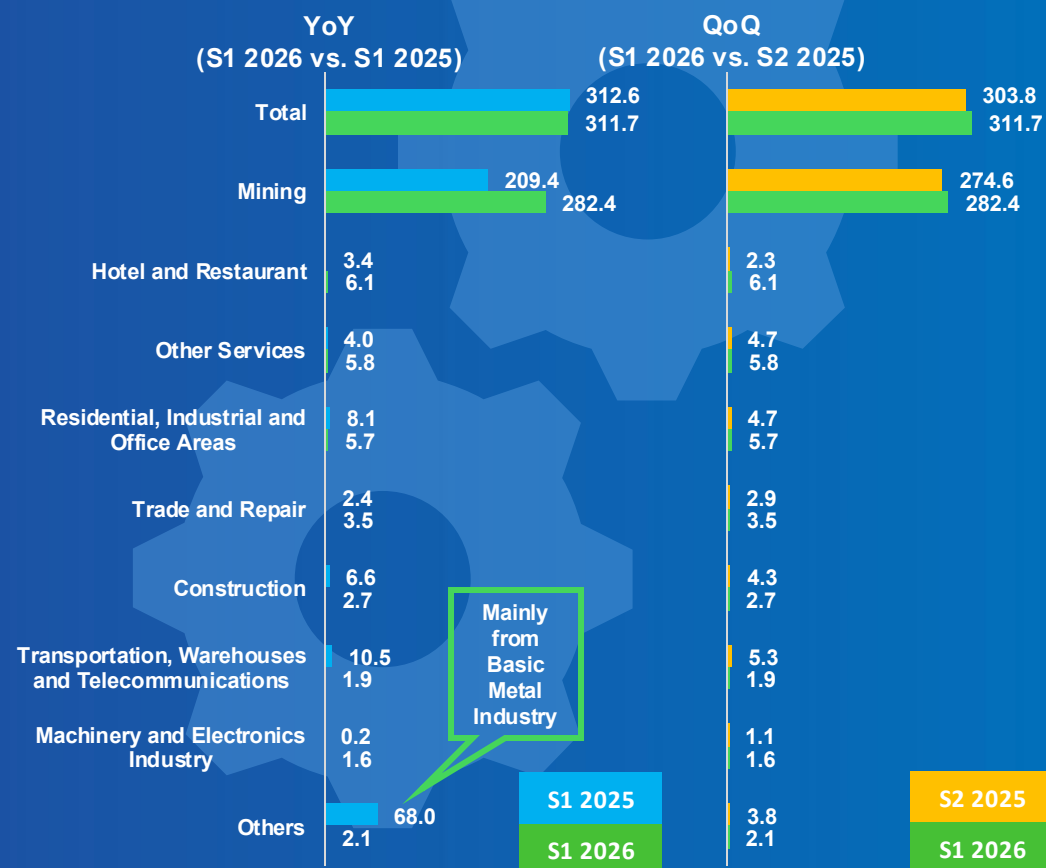
Top Investment Locations (USD Million) 2026



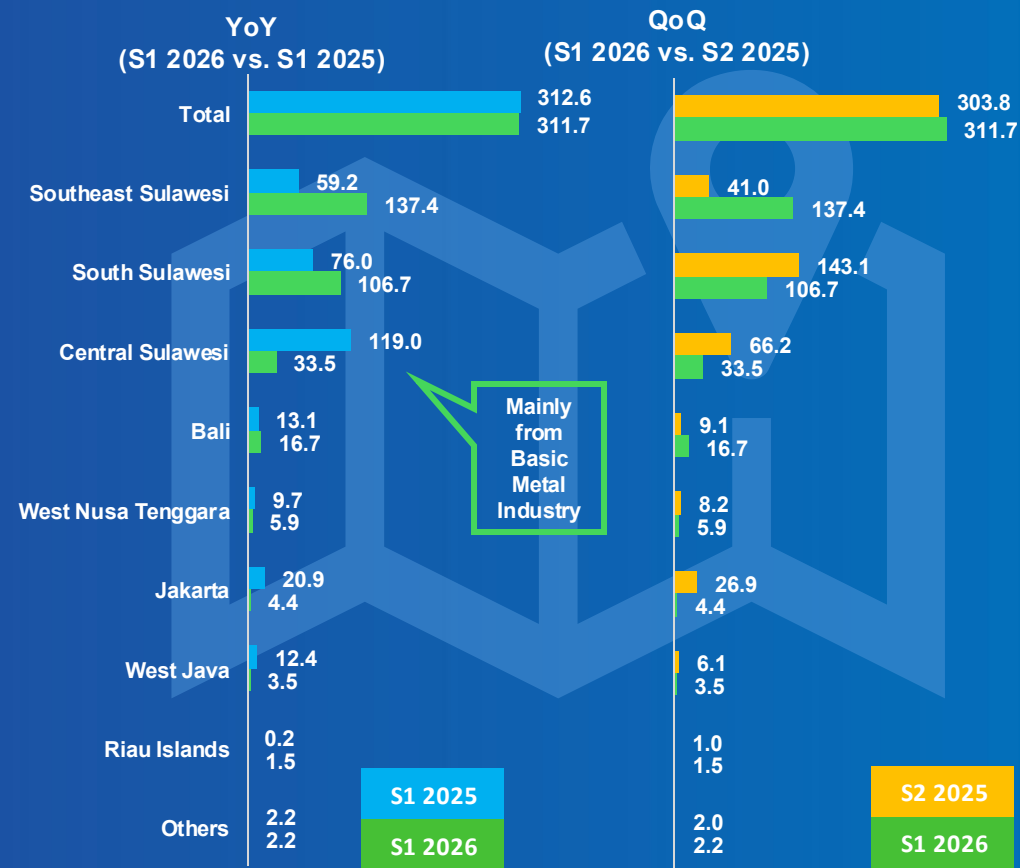

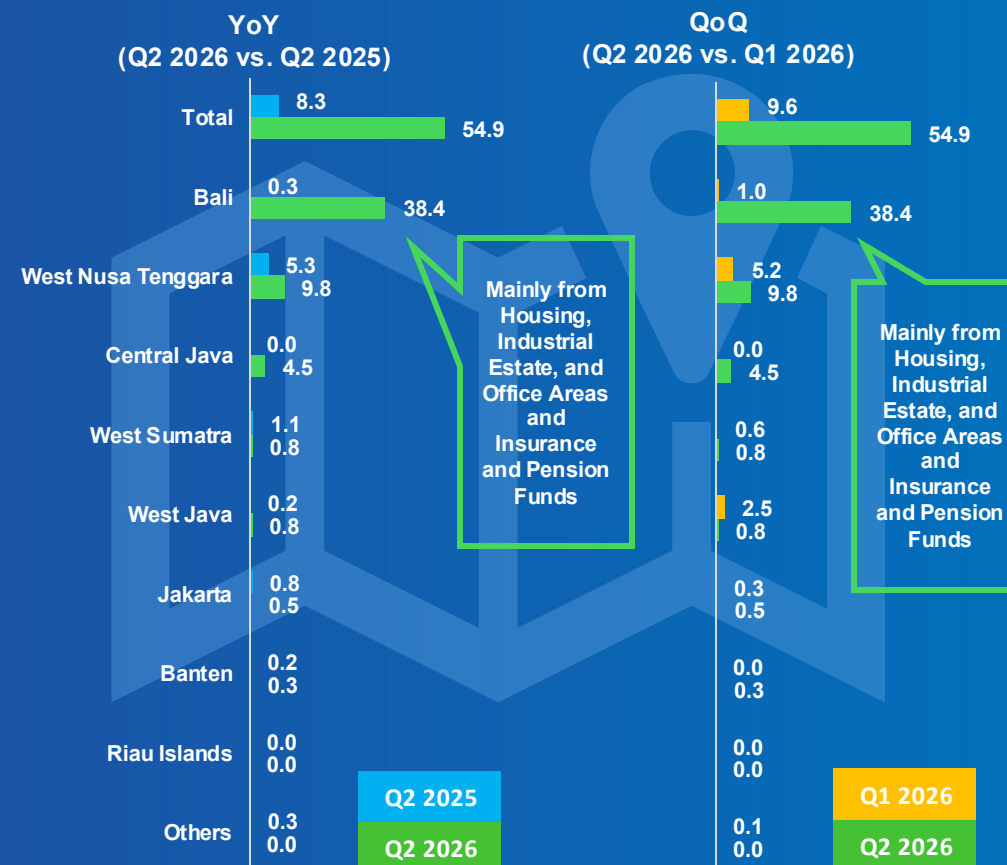
Latin America Investment Realization in Indonesia – by Quarter

Top Investment Sectors (USD Million) 2026



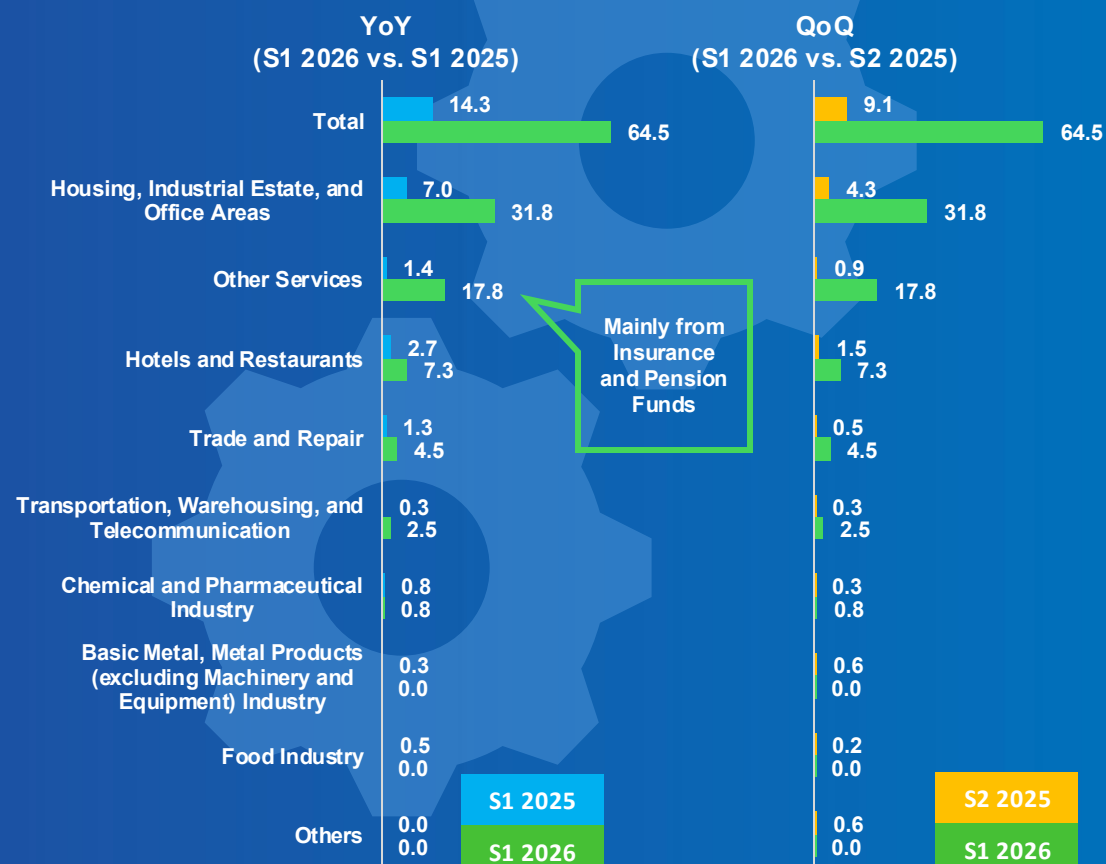
Top Investment Locations (USD Million) 2026



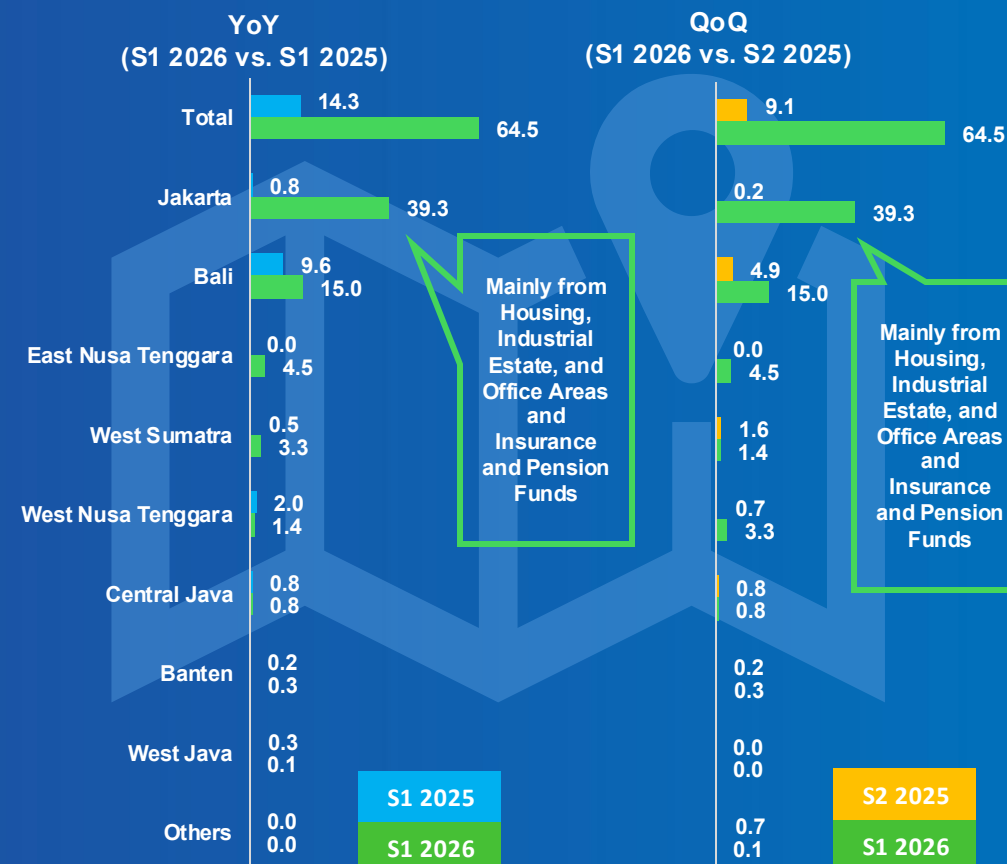

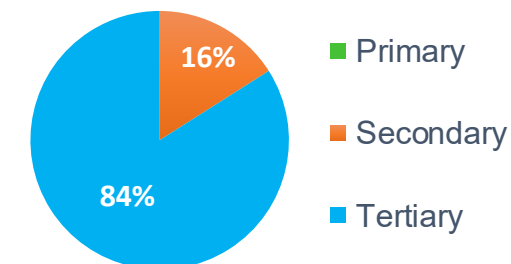
